

## Guidelines for DSP2011 camera-ready manuscript submissions

Prepare your camera-ready paper following the template provided in the DSP2011 web site. Be sure that you have incorporated all the reviewers' suggestions and comments during it's preparation. You are allowed a total of 6 pages for your document, including figures (for special sessions only, this limit is 8 pages).

Prior to submitting your camera-ready paper to the DSP2011 EasyChair web site, please check acceptability of your paper at IEEE PDF eXpress as described in detail below. This is a necessary step that ensures that all camera-ready papers meet the requirements imposed by IEEE Xplore digital library.

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- 7. The PDF file you received that passed the IEEE PDF eXpress Check must be finally submitted electronically through the DSP2011 EasyChair website.
- 8. You may submit your camera-ready paper to EasyChair **from April 1st, 2011**. The deadline for the submission is **April 17th, 2011**.

Please do not forget to fill in and sign the Copyright Form which can be found in: <a href="http://dsp2011.gr/copyright">http://dsp2011.gr/copyright</a>

The form must be signed by any of the authors in case of multiple authors. The completed signed form must be returned to the Conference organizers either by email (**scanned**) or by fax.

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We also kindly remind that for each accepted paper, it is required that at least one author registers (at full rate) for the DSP2011 conference before May 1st, 2011. Papers that are not registered by this deadline will not be included in the proceedings and in the final
